The North Carolina State Board of Elections has crosschecked the records of the North Carolina Division of Motor Vehicles (DMV) as to persons registered to vote in North Carolina and who were issued a “legal presence” drivers’ license by the DMV. These “legal presence” drivers’ licenses are issued to persons who are not American citizens but otherwise are legally present in North Carolina. It is a requirement of both Federal and North Carolina law that you must be an American citizen to register to vote and vote.

The crosscheck produced results that showed that you were issued a “legal presence” drivers’ license by the DMV. The review also showed that you registered to vote on «**registr\_dt**». In addition, our records showed you voted on «**Voter\_History**». Of course, it is very possible that you became an American citizen between the time you were issued a “legal presence” drivers’ license and the time you registered to vote.

We request that you fill out the enclosed form and return the form to us in the self-addressed, postage paid envelope provided, along with a copy of any document that may pertain to your American citizenship. You may communicate any questions or concerns regarding this matter to me, either by email ([don.wright@ncsbe.gov](mailto:don.wright@ncsbe.gov)) or by phone (919-733-7173).

Based on information currently available to us, we must presume, until we get information from you otherwise, that you may not be an American citizen and should not be registered to vote. That is why it is important that you provide us the information we need to establish your American citizenship and your right to remain registered to vote. We must hear from you about this citizenship concern in order to make any corrections and to ensure your rights.
